A recent lawsuit against the U.S Army Corps of Engineers by the Sierra Club and two local environmental groups has forced us to shut down the South Fort Meade Mine and impact hundreds of jobs.

The [website](#) outlines the property's *seven-year* permitting history and unprecedented environmental protections - and discusses the impact of the facility's shutdown on food supply, the local economy, regional businesses that depend on our industry, and our employees. Our overall phosphate production will be reduced while this case works its way through the courts, but we will continue mining reserves which have separate permits. We will also continue to meet all our reclamation and environmental obligations at the South Fort Meade site even though mining operations have ceased. Most important, we will continue working to support America's farmers who feed us, keep our economy moving forward, and protect the region's environmental assets that are vitally important to all of us who call Florida our home.
